


# Driverinstallation problem on a Windows Server 2008 R2

The following procedure is recommended.


Download and unzip the driver package on the server.


Installing the 64 printer driver on the server.

-> Control Panel \ Printers \ Add Printer




Create a local printer not a Network printer







Create a new connection




Sample Standard TCP/IP Port fill in IP-address -> next (takes a while)




-> Generic network card -> next (take a while)




Click on Disk and point to the path of the unpacked driver package..







Open the „\*.inf“ file



Select a printer and selct next




