## Install Unsigned Privers on Windows 10

Step 1:

- Start Windows
- Close all APPS
- The computer must be started in the "Options" mode.
- i.e. "Run" dialogue hotkey Win + R and type the command, to start with Option Menu "shutdown.exe / r / o / f / t 00"

	Type the name of a program, folder, document, or Internet resource, and Windows will open it for you.				
)pen:	shutdown.exe /r /o /f /t 00				

shutdown.exe = Windows default program to shut down and restart the system

- $\Rightarrow$  /r = This option will shut down and then restart the local computer or the remote computer
- ⇒ **/f** = This option forces running programs to close without warning

Once your computer has rebooted you will be able to choose the Troubleshoot option.

⇒ Select "Startup Settings"
